

BYLAW 263-18

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING LAND USE BYLAW 252-17 CONCERNING THE HEIGHT OF ACCESSORY STRUCTURES (GARAGES)

WHEREAS, THE Council for the Village of Alberta Beach may pass bylaws for Municipal purposes respecting the development of property; and

WHEREAS, THE Council for the Village of Alberta Beach may pass bylaws for Municipal purposes respecting the safety, welfare and the protection of people and property.

NOW THEREFORE it is deemed advisable to amend Section 4.10(1)e of Land Use Bylaw 252-17 as follows:

Section 4.10 Garages and Accessory Buildings

1. In residential districts detached garages and accessory buildings shall be located according to the following:
 - e. an garage accessory building shall not be more than 9.0 m (29.8 ft.) in height, and shall not exceed the height of the main building, and all other accessory buildings shall be restricted to a height no greater than 4.5 m (15 ft.) or the height of the main building – whichever is lower.
