

Notice of Intent - 2025 Election

Election Date: October 20, 2025

<u>Local Authorities Election Act</u>, s. 147.22: No individual and no person acting for the individual shall accept a contribution or incur a campaign expense unless the individual has given written notice in accordance with this section.

Individuals who intend to be nominated or has been nominated to run in the municipal election as a candidate must give written notice. Submitting a notice of intent is the first step; individuals are still required to submit a nomination form.

- 1. The form is to be completed by the individual who intends to be nominated or has been nominated to run for election as a candidate in the 2025 municipal election.
