A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO INCREASE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL FROM THREE COUNCILLORS TO FIVE COUNCILLORS.

WHEREAS the Council of the Summer Village of Alberta Beach deems it expedient and proper pursuant to the provisions of Section 9(1) and Section 27(B)(ii) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 and amendments thereto, to increase the membership of Council from (3) to five (5) Councillors.

WHEREAS the Summer Village of Alberta Beach has a population of five hundred and sixty two (562) as determined by the federal census taken in June 1991.

THEREFORE the Council of the Summer Village of Alberta Beach enacts as follows:

The Council of The Summer Village of Alberta Beach shall consist of five (5) Councillors, one of whom shall be Mayor.

THAT this increase shall apply to the next general election (August 1995).
