BYLAW NO. 157-99

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC ROADWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M-26.1, STATUTES OF ALBERTA AND AMENDMENTS THERETO

WHEREAS the land hereafter described is no longer required for public travel;

AND WHEREAS application has been made to the Council to have the portion of the street closed for sale or lease;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to pass the Bylaw has been circulated to neighbouring landowners in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act;

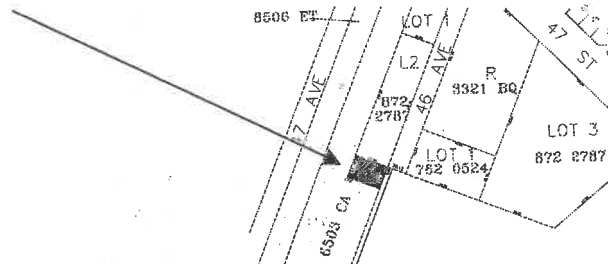
AND WHEREAS Council, before passing the Bylaw, gave persons who claim to be affected prejudicially by the Bylaw an opportunity to be heard by Council;
