

BY - LAW NO. 19-84

FOR THE

SUMMER VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH

IN THE

PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVYING OF PENALTIES ON UNPAID TAXES.

WHEREAS, Sections 117 and 118, of the Municipal Taxation Act, being Chapter M-31 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, and amendments thereto, provides that a Council of a municipality may, by by-law, require any or all taxes be payable on a certain day and may impose a penalty for the non-payment of the current taxes and any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31st of a year.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Summer Village of Alberta Beach, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

THAT on August 10th of each year and in each succeeding year, a penalty of eighteen percent (18%) shall be levied upon and added to any remaining unpaid current taxes, and

THAT, in the event of any taxes remaining unpaid after December 31st of a year for which they are levied, there shall be added thereto, by way of an additional penalty, eighteen per cent (18%) on the 1st day of January and in each succeeding year so long as the taxes remain unpaid.

THAT, any penalty imposed under this By-law shall be added to and remain to form a part of the unpaid taxes.

By-law No. 2-82 of the Summer Village of Alberta Beach is hereby rescinded accordingly.

This By-law shall come into force and effect upon the date of the third and final reading.

READ A FIRST TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 15th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1984 A.D.

READ A SECOND TIME IN COUNCIL THIS 15th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1984 A.D.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINAL TIME THIS 15th DAY OF DECEMBER, 1984 A.D. AND PASSED BY THE UNANIMOUS CONSENT OF COUNCIL.
