BYLAW NO. 221-08 ALBERTA BEACH

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ALBERTA BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CONTROL LAND USE.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26.1, Division 5, Section 631 and Section 692 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 R.S.A., a municipality may adopt an Inter-municipal Development Plan.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Alberta Beach determined it necessary to amend the Alberta Beach Regional Inter-municipal Development Plan in a technical manner to update terminology and references within the text of AB-IDP.

AND WHEREAS the Council of Alberta Beach wishes to clarify the provision for the process for annexation/amalgamation within the Alberta Beach Regional Inter-municipal Development Plan.

AND WHEREAS Section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Ch. M-26 allows Council to make changes to bring out more clearly what is to be considered the meaning of a Bylaw or to improve the expression of the law;

NOW THEREFORE the Alberta Beach Bylaw #213-07 Schedule A, Part 5 is hereby amended by making the following changes:

 Proposed annexation/amalgamations shall be referred to the Inter-municipal Council Committee for initial review. Prior to making formal application to the Municipal Government Board, the affected municipalities should be in agreement with the spirit and intent of the proposed annexation/amalgamation.

AND WHEREAS this Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third and final reading.
